



# History: Imperial College of Science and Technology








Prince Albert, husband of Queen Victoria, 1819 - 1861

- Royal School of Mines





Virologists (Prof. Robin Shattock) are trialing their self-amplifying RNA COVID-19 vaccine which can adapt to new variants. Using genetic code to train the immune system to respond to the virus so the body can easily recognise it as a threat in future.
